Today, Little City's programs support over 1,100 individuals with disabilities at its 56-acre campus in Palatine and in the Chicagoland area.

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## MEET WYATT



Wyatt was one of the three original students at Little City's Center for Education when it first opened its doors in 2011. Now, Wyatt is preparing to leave the school and transition into Little City's adult programming -- an accomplishment not thought possible when he first entered the doors.

"When Wyatt first came here, communication was a huge frustration for him and he would have pretty severe fight or flight responses to that," said school principal Philip Siegel. "You wouldn't even know it is the same kid

when you see him today smiling in class. He has become the most sophisticated device user we have ever had and can communicate incredibly well with it."

Wyatt's growth over the last 10 years is tied directly to the school's growth over that time. When the school first opened, there were three staff members and the three students only used one classroom. Today, there are 37 students who can experience up to nine classrooms, each specifically designed for unique learning experiences.

"Teaching children with this level of needs is all about relationships. I think the turning point for Wyatt was when he started working with a speech language pathologist," Philip said. "They formed a bond so quickly and Wyatt became such an expert at communicating with the device."

"Our goal for every student is to give them the opportunity to be the best possible version of themselves," Philip continued. "We want to take their ceiling, whatever it may be, and raise it. We are here to take the levels people think they can reach and set a new standard."

Wyatt was also one of the Duffey Family Children's Village's first residents. He has successfully transitioned to a Little City home for young adults thanks to the transformational environment he benefited from at Little City.
